

STMD/SWTMD Pool Update July 2026



*** Starting July 1, 2026 ***

We're introducing a new wristband pool safety rule for young swimmers

- Any child who is under 48 inches in height will be required to wear the wristband provided by the lifeguard when checking into the pool. (Infants excluded but as they get older, this will apply to them as well.)
- The wristband serves as an indicator that this child may not be a strong swimmer or is too young to swim alone and will need to stay within arm's reach of adult at all times when in the pool.
- Children will need to pass a swim test to no longer need a wristband.

Lifeguards will be offering daily swim tests during adult swim starting on July 1st

Once your child passes the swim test

- A lifeguard will sign off on their name in the records, and they will no longer need to receive a wristband when coming to the pool. Child only needs to pass swim test one time.

Lifeguards will not be offering swim tests on July 4th
